







Arts & Design Pathway

In this pathway, students explored the fast paced and exciting world of User Experience Design. Students worked together to create an app for teen mental health using the human-centered design process. This course was hands on and project based with built in lectures and activities to help guide the projects along. At the end of the 4day design sprint, each team had an opportunity to present their innovative solutions.



STEM Pathway

Through a variety of hands-on experiences students were introduced to concepts in the following areas:








I feel like I can make informed decisions about my life after high school.






I anticipate I will attend college after high school.






I understand what my leadership skills are and what I need to develop.






I feel confident in my ability to be a leader.






I recognize the power of using my voice to make a better world.






I have the tools to combat nerves, summon a sense of power, and speak up at school, work, and beyond.






I am confident in my understanding of the factors to consider when choosing a college.






I know what a FAFSA is.










I am aware of a variety of funding sources to help make college affordable.






I am able to correlate my top three interests to potential jobs and career clusters.







I understand best practices in advocacy work.




I feel educated on what women's leadership looks like outside of the U.S.









I understand what it would be like to be a student-athlete (at Mount Mary University).




I understand how I can use my values, interests, and gifts to make the world a better place.









Small Groups

Each Summer Leadership Academy participant met with their small groups once daily for an hour. Small groups were led by Peer and Adult Mentors. Peer Mentors are young women who have participated in a previous Summer Leadership Academy. Adult Mentors are Mount Mary University employees, or community members who support the Peer Mentors in leading the small groups. This year, the Academy had the largest group of "support staff" yet with 16 Peer Mentors and 8 Adult Mentors.
