

Connect to Cable TV

To access cable TV in the residence hall, your TV must have a coax connection and a QAM Digital TV Tuner. Most major brand flat screen TVs manufactured after 2006 support both ATSC (Advanced Television Systems Committee) and QAM (quadrature amplitude modulation) digital tuners. ATSC is used to receive digital channels over the air. QAM is used to receive digital channels from a cable TV provider without use of a cable box. Please follow the steps below to access cable TV; consult your TV owner's manual for instructions on how to perform these steps, as these will vary by manufacturer.

1. Connect your TV to the coax port on the wall using a coax cable.
2. Make sure that your TV is set to Cable TV (or CATV) mode instead of Air or Antenna.
3. Perform a channel auto-scan or auto-program.

Connect to the Network

Here are the quick steps to get connected to the network via a wireless or wired connection. For additional information regarding supported devices, please see the "Residence Hall Cable TV and Network Connectivity" document.

Wireless

1. Connect to the "MMU-Community" wireless network.
2. When prompted for a username and password, enter your network username and password (the same information that you use to access email).
3. You may receive a certificate error; if so, please select "Connect," "Continue" or "Accept" (this step will vary depending on the type of device that you are connecting).

Wired

1. Make sure that your wireless connection is turned off on your computer, game console, or streaming device.
2. Plug your computer into one of the ports on the wall using an Ethernet cable.
