

Connecting to the Campus Wi-Fi (Windows 10) Information Technology Services

This document contains steps for connecting your Windows 10 computer to the campus Wi-Fi network. Before attempting to connect, ensure that Airplane Mode is turned off on your computer, Wi-Fi is enabled, and that the wireless adapter is functioning correctly. The IT Services Help Desk can assist you in connecting to the Wi-Fi if you are experiencing an issue when following this guide, but cannot assist with diagnosing or repair of your personal computer.

Note: Your computer must support 5 GHz Wi-Fi in order to connect to the campus network. Most computers manufactured in the last 5+ years have a 5 GHz radio.

1. Open the **Network & Internet Settings** menu by clicking the network icon in the system tray in the bottom-right corner of your screen. Note that you may need to expand the **Show hidden icons** section in order to locate the network icon.



2. Click the MMU-Community network.



3. Enter your campus username (1) – the portion of your email address without the @mtmary.edu – and password (2). Then click **OK** (3).



4. If prompted to Continue connecting? click Connect.



5. After a few seconds, the **MMU-Community** connection should indicated *Connected*, *secured*.
